- A defibrillator unit has been installed on the front door of the "Green Hut" Church Hall. Awareness sessions on how to use it 7th April 11.30.
- There is an honesty book bring and buy shelf (50 pence per book taken) inside the "Green Hut" Church Hall that can be accessed when the post office is open or on Coffee Mornings. Proceeds to the upkeep of the "Green Hut".
- Village Coffee Morning at the "Green Hut" every 2 weeks Monday 10am to 12am. Absolutely wonderful homemade cakes, a real welcome plus the bring and buy stall operated for charity! Next dates 16th April & 30th April. Every other week after that. Watch for the welcome sign outside and call in!
- Posters on other activities can be found on the notice boards on the door of the "Green Hut" and the main notice board Merthyr Road at the end of Kiln Road.
- Information on St Faith's Church services including family service 1st Sunday in the month can be found at the church gate.
